



Federally Funded Health Center Enterprise Reporting *A Case Study*

The Business Objective

The client's data reporting strategy relies heavily on manual data modeling. A small data team is generating Excel reports for all areas of the health care system; clinical, financial, operational, etc. As data continues to pour in the requests for more reports and dashboards grows, putting a strain on the overworked data team. This creates a two pronged objective:

- Short Term: Additional Bandwidth to keep up with the requests for reports and dashboards.
- Long Term: Automation of the existing process to create standard Crystal reports, subscriptions, and ultimately less pressure for the client's data team. Thereby allowing the provider to work on Process Improvement projects as opposed to manual reporting.
